TIME FOR A SONG

Dear Reader! This manual is implied to be a useful and comprehensive resource book for teachers using songs or music in the EFL classroom or those willing to do this but yet knowing nothing about the useful procedure. It lists a number of tried and tested activities most of which are ready to use with little or no preparation. In fact, they seem to have a point and look fun to try out. Perhaps most of the authors' chosen songs will be older than your students, but this may not necessarily be such a bad thing. Our experience proves that songs, which are old enough for students not to know, often turn out to be better than those which are new enough to remember, but which evoke an emotional response unrelated to the song's message. In any case, one of the themes of the book is action research, implying that teachers should be using and experimenting with their own ideas and selection of songs.

It's a well-known fact that songs have been part of the human experience for as long as we can remember. Adults sing at religious services, in the shower and listening to the radio. Songs have become an integral part of our language experience, and if used in coordination with a language lesson they can be of great value. Fortunately, with the expanding prevalence of the Internet into both the classrooms and lives of students, access to music and lyrics has been made easier.

Let us focus on the reasons for using songs by demonstrating their effectiveness as a learning tool. Songs are successful in developing the four skill areas of reading, writing, listening and speaking, and can be used:

- to present a topic, a language point, lexis, etc.;
- to practice a language point, lexis, etc.;
- to focus on common learner errors in a more direct way;
- to encourage extensive and intensive listening;
- to stimulate discussion of attitudes and feelings;
- to encourage creativity and use of imagination;
- to provide a relaxed classroom atmosphere;
- to bring variety and fun to learning.

In other words, songs provide a break from classroom routine, and learning English through them develops a non-threatening classroom atmosphere in which the four language skills can be enhanced. Songs also present opportunities for developing automaticity as a component of language fluency, which involves both knowing what to say and producing language rapidly without pauses. Besides, some songs are excellent examples of colloquial English, that is, the language of informal conversation. Using songs can prepare students for the genuine

language they will be faced with.

The best songs to choose for the EFL classroom are considered those being:

- Suited to classroom acoustics and learners' ears: Not too much background noise or loud instrumentals and a clear singing voice (give preference to a solo artist). Always try to play the song in the room you will be using before the lesson. What does it sound like from the back?
- Simple and linear: Repetitious songs with a simple story build or tale are preferable to 'abstract' musings. Something that could be ordered if jumbled up or with a basic verb form reused in each verse.
- In plain English: Avoid songs with lots of slang or cultural references that need explaining. You will get bogged down in explaining meanings and lose the class.
- Suited to actions: Especially important for young learners who are helped by being physically involved with the music (e.g. heads, shoulders, knees, etc.).
- Not too long (maximum 2-3 verses): You will need to break up a long song and will need to replay the song quite a few times. Make a tape with the song repeated over and over again, or you will waste valuable classroom time rewinding the tape.

The following activities can be applied to the carefully chosen songs:

1. SONG DICTATION

There are several ways that song dictations can be carried out:

- The most effective way is to play the song yourself. If you can play an instrument such as guitar and sing in tune, students will usually be most enthusiastic. In this way, it is easy for you to adjust the speed of the song and to stop, start and repeat to suit the speed of the students' writing. You may be shy at first, but remember that your students will be far too busy writing the song down to laugh at you!
- Another way to do the dictation is to use a recording on CD, video or cassette with your finger on the pause button. Music videos can be especially useful as they allow the students to get more hints from the visual images or the movements of the singer's lips.
- A third way of doing song dictation is to combine it with spoken dictation. You can speak the parts of the song that are too difficult for the students to catch.

As with all teaching techniques, it is best to experiment to find out the ways of song dictation that work best for you and your students. Of course, song dicta-

tions do not have to be carried out in class. You can assign a song as homework, preferably one that the students enjoy and choose themselves. If the students already have the lyrics sheet, then you can ask them to only check it after the dictation has been done.

2. SONG BUILDING

Write the lyrics in couplets or line by line on strips of paper (photocopied for a large group). Students have 5 minutes to learn their strip. Students in groups then try to 'put together' the song; one student may be secretary and write out their lyrics. Listen and check, then sing!

3. SONG COMPOSING

There are several variations of song composing:

- Put random words from the song on the board. Ask students to write the "tale of the song".
 - Cut the song in half. Students predict the other half.
- Listen to the song. Ask students to write another verse for the song in pairs or small groups.

4. CLOZE OR GAP FILL

This is the most familiar and popular activity. For that reason it is probably over-used. Consider the following steps: 1) Have a point, be it vocabulary or prepositions or whatever. 2) Don't cloze 3 or more in a row. 3) For lower levels: give the first letter, miss out word endings, give dashes for letters, or give a glossary. 4) Give vocabulary clues or synonyms for the missing words. 5) Get students to work in pairs to predict words before you play the tape.

5. EAR TRAINING AND PRONUNCIATION

Remove all the rhyming words from a popular song. Give the students those words mixed up on a piece of paper or on the board. Match the words, which rhyme. Then try to guess what the song might be about. Listen to the song and put the rhyming ending words in order as they hear them. Then give out a lyrics sheet and they insert the missing rhymes. This is good for vowel contrasts and practice of key vowels or consonants.

6. SONG DISCUSSION

In many cases, the teacher plays a song and leads a discussion on the meaning of the lyrics in a song. This can be effective, but this is just one of the many ways that music or song can lead to a fruitful discussion. Some of the other aspects of music and songs are outlined below. Any one of these can be the basis of a class discussion.

• Subject Matter. This is a big area and an appropriate song can lead

to a discussion in almost any topic. For example, the Beatles' song *Nowhere Man* can lead to a discussion on laziness, dreams or alienation. The large number of possible interpretations and the ambiguity in many lyrics makes possibilities for extended discussions.

- *Poetic Structure*. Rhyming scheme, rhythm, use of alliteration, onomatopoeia and imagery are all useful subjects for discussion.
- Ambiguous People and Places in Songs. Often, song lyrics refer to 'you' and 'I' without the listener knowing who they are. Similarly, the place and time are often unspecified. Eliciting student opinions about these ambiguous items can make an interesting discussion.
- Songs as a Reflection of Culture. Even more than music, lyrics are a reflection of society and culture. For example, the lyrics of the 60's show the changing values about sexual behaviour in society. Protest songs and street ballads describe society in a powerful manner.
- Meanings Created in Performance. Different singers often bring different attitudes and meanings to a song. For example, Elvis's version of Always On My Mind conveys feelings of regret, whereas the same song recorded by the Pet Shop Boys conveys a cynical attitude.
- *Meanings Created in Packaging*. The same music can be popular or unpopular depending on how it is packaged and marketed. For example, Nigel Kennedy (a violin virtuoso) succeeded in selling classical music to teenagers by adopting the language, dress and mannerisms of pop stars.

7. PICTURE DRAWING

Students listen to a song, draw a picture to represent what they hear and then explain their pictures in small groups.

8. ORAL SONG PROJECT - ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Students in pairs/small groups choose a singer, group or musical genre. They prepare an oral presentation, including extracts from songs, the biography of the group and description of the instruments used. Follow up with a song from the group/singer next lesson with a worksheet prepared by you. Very motivating and gives a few weeks of student-centred learning!

We'd like to finish with only one piece of advice on using songs in the EFL classroom, which will hopefully encourage the inspired reader of this manual to implement all the suggestions in his/her teaching practice. It doesn't matter whether you can sing or not. Neither of us can sing a note, but we play the cassette recorder very well. Don't let your own lack of singing ability inhibit you. The students will be doing the singing.
